



Local Rule – Relief from renovation works

The Match Committee wishes to advise that ACC ground staff have carried out renovation works on the course which has resulted in cores holes on fairways and cores that have been piled at various locations around the course for removal at a later date.

Based on this the Match Committee will adopt a Local Rule for relief if your ball comes to rest in these areas of piled cores or a core hole.

Players can take relief from the **piled cores** by selecting the nearest point of relief, not closer to the hole and **drop** their ball within 1 club length.

In addition to the relief from piled cores, if a player's ball lies in or touches a core hole on any fairway that has been renovated the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

The ball must be marked before picking up, cannot be cleaned, then the ball can be **placed** within 1 club length, not nearer the hole, away from aeration holes.

This rule will only apply to a ball that is on any fairway effected by the coring activity only.

This rule will commence 13th November and will remain in place for competitions until further notice.
