All trophies and prizes will be presented as soon as possible after the completion of play.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Format

The event will be played as an 18-hole stroke event for Men & Women. Event winners will be best gross score, and Net winners will be A, B & C grades for men and A & B grades for women.

In the event of a gross or net score tie, the winner and places will be decided by countback.

All players will compete using their playing handicap for North Adelaide South Course based on their GA handicaps.

The event will be played with two (2) shotgun starts at 7:30AM and 12:30PM.

Gross score winners will be invited to, and trophies presented at the NAGC Presentation Dinner on November 22nd.

Trophies/prizes will be presented after play on the day.

Match Committee

The Match Committee will be the North Adelaide Golf Club Match Committee.

The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.

The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.

Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, alter any aspect of the event.

Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the North Adelaide Golf Club.

Temporary local rules will be advised by the organisers prior to tee-off.

Two players to move off to the next hole tee if the group is behind in play. Lowest handicapper in the group is responsible to manage speed of play.

Entries

Open to any amateur golfer who is a member of a club affiliated with Golf Australia or state or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Australia.

The Entrance fee of \$25.00 for North Adelaide Golf Course affiliated members with playing rights and \$55.00 for visitors (non-members) must accompany the entry form.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.

Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries.

Motorised Transport - Ride-on buggies will be permitted and players will need to book them at own expense through the Pro Shop.

Dress Standards - Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards, rules of conduct and any course requirements of The North Adelaide Golf Club.

Measuring Devices - For all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only.

Draw - Tee times will be available on the North Adelaide Golf Club web site, nagc.org.au and will be posted to NAGC notice boards. Tee times will be emailed to non-member participants.
