

Match report – Feb 16th 2020

The fourth round of the Public Course Pennants season took place on Sun Feb 16th, with all three of our teams playing at home, Division's 1 and 2 versus Playford Lakes GC and Division 3 versus Marion Park GC. Our top two teams enjoyed handsome victories while the Division 3 suffered a loss. Match details are as follows;

Division 1

Our team won 7 games to 1, the same win margin as last week. This win continues our Division 1 team's excellent start to the season and with 4 wins out of 4 they look destined for the finals.
