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Dear Member,

The Management Committee of North Adelaide Golf Club welcomes you to our Club and extends a warm invitation to join us on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and/or Saturday for competition golf.

We would like to familiarise you with our golf standards and program. Our Constitution can be found on our website at nagc.org.au.

Dress Code

Dress standards are laid out in the handbook. We ask that you uphold these standards.

Club Rooms

You are encouraged to come and use the clubroom facilities after finishing your round of golf. There is a competition leaderboard and announcements after each competition.

19th Hole & Pro Shop

The NAGC has in force a discount structure with the Pro Shop, 10% off green fees and food & drink and 10% off all merchandise & equipment

To receive your discount, you must produce your member's Loyalty Card.

Player Handicap

A Golf Australia handicap is obtained by returning three 18-hole stroke round cards in competition play. When gaining a handicap, a player may pick-up when 5 over par on any hole. To retain a handicap – three 18-hole rounds in Club Competitions must be completed annually for handicapping purposes.

Competitions

If possible, please call the Club Captain or Secretary/Manager so they can arrange for an experienced golfer to play with you. They will assist you with the Stableford, Par and Stroke competitions and recording the results on your scorecard and at the scores kiosk. They will also familiarise you with course etiquette.

- Report to the staff in the Pro Shop at least 20 minutes prior to your designated tee time. Present your loyalty card at the pro shop to complete registration for each round of golf.
- Meet in the Club Room where you will be assisted to join a playing group if needed.
- The competition fee is presently \$5.00 for 18 holes. If you start but do not finish the Competition Fee is still payable.
- Be ready to tee-off 20 minutes prior to your scheduled time.
- Play in groups of 4; Members are encouraged to vary tee-off times and to play with different players as much as possible.

Competitions (Continued)

Tuesday: Mixed Stableford or Stroke competition where women are encouraged to play. Stroke round on the second Tuesday of each month, otherwise Stableford round.

- Tee-off time is from 6:45AM or at first light during winter, depending on sunrise

Wednesday: Although there are no specific allocated times for NAGC on the booking sheet, there is a mixed Stableford competition for members from first light to 9.30AM.

Thursday: Separate Men's Stableford and Women's Stableford or Stroke rounds as per Member's Handbook playing fixtures.

- Men's first tee-off time is 6:14AM or first light during winter.
- Ladies first tee-off time is 8:00 – 8:30AM, depending on sunrise

Saturday: Separate Men's & Women's competitions as per Member's Handbook playing fixtures.

- Men's first tee-off time is 6:14AM Early Group and 10:47AM Late Group.
- Women's first tee-off time is 10:00AM, depending on sunrise

Booking in for Competitions.

NOTE: *You will need to contact the Pro Shop 8203 7888 to obtain a user name and password for the Mi Club Booking System.*

Enter yourself on the online booking sheet (MiClub) at your preferred tee-off time.

Complete procedures for use of the MiClub online booking system are available from the NAGC website at the following URL: <http://www.nagc.org.au/membership/member-information/miclub-booking-procedures>; or through the link on the NAGC website.

The MiClub booking sheets open at 3:00PM 16 days prior to the competition date.

Members will have exclusive access to these times for the first 11 days, i.e. until midday on the Tuesday for Saturday competitions.

If for some reason you are booked but unable to play, please remember to remove yourself from the booking sheet by 3:00PM on the Friday before play. Any 'no shows' or cancellations after this could result in you receiving penalties.

Kiosk – Registration and scores

Register for the competition of the day at the kiosk in the pro shop foyer. Enter your name, or last 4 digits of your Golfink number, and follow the prompts to print your scorecard.

After your game, enter your score at the kiosk. Enter your surname, or the last 4 digits of your golf link number, and enter your gross stroke score for each hole. Follow the prompts and accept your score entry when completed.

If going for a handicap you only enter your stroke round score for 3 rounds, then your handicap will be calculated by Golfink.

NAGC Website

To be able to access the Member's Areas of the NAGC web site we need your DOB so that you can be registered for the Members Area.

Your member login appears at the end of this letter.

The monthly playing fixtures are listed in the NAGC Member's Handbook and details of how to play the competitions is available from the Secretary/Manager.

Mixed Events

Several social events are held during the year, and these are indicated in your handbook. Nomination sheets are usually available in the clubroom prior to each event. Members wishing to play in special events must nominate themselves in advance for planning purposes.

Competition Prizes

Monies won in competitions are credited to your membership Loyalty Card for use at the Pro Shop.

Golf balls won in competitions are recorded on a ball list and on reaching 12 balls they are credited to your Loyalty Card at \$5.00 each.

Pennant

Our Club enters teams in various pennant competitions each year. You are encouraged to play and may be approached by the Captain to join a team.

Golf Etiquette

- Do not talk or move while another player is hitting.
- Do not stand directly behind the player hitting the ball.
- Keep up with the group in front and walk briskly between shots.
- Tee off before marking scorecard if your honour.
- Do not take more than one practice swing.
- Do not leave your buggy in front of a green.
- Leave rake in the middle of the bunker.
- Repair all divot holes and pitch marks – your own and others.

The enjoyment of golf depends a great deal on the cooperation, consideration and courtesy extended by players.
